...brings partners together for local development

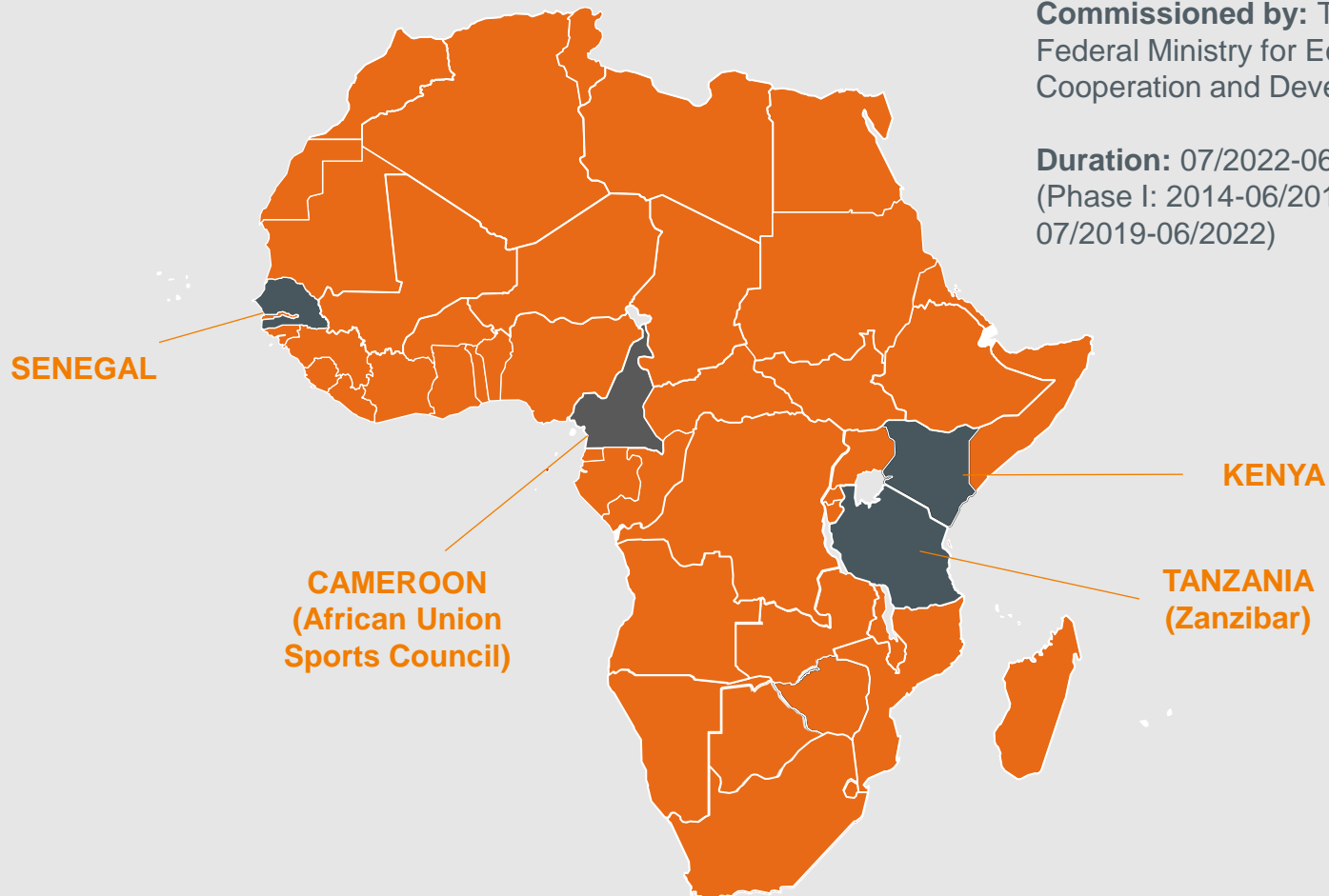


...uses sports as a means to strengthen life skills and social competences

Advancing peaceful coexistence and social integration through sport for development activities

- Involve existing expert/thematic groups at political level in steering committees
- Engage women and men

Assess

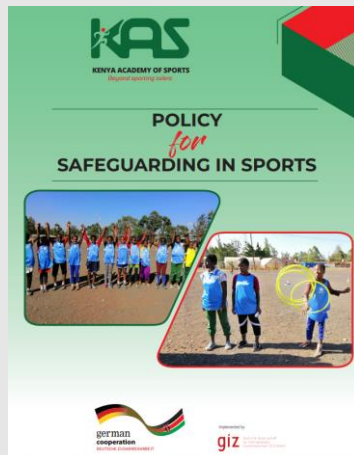
- ... which topics to work on (and which not)

- Be open to new opportunities

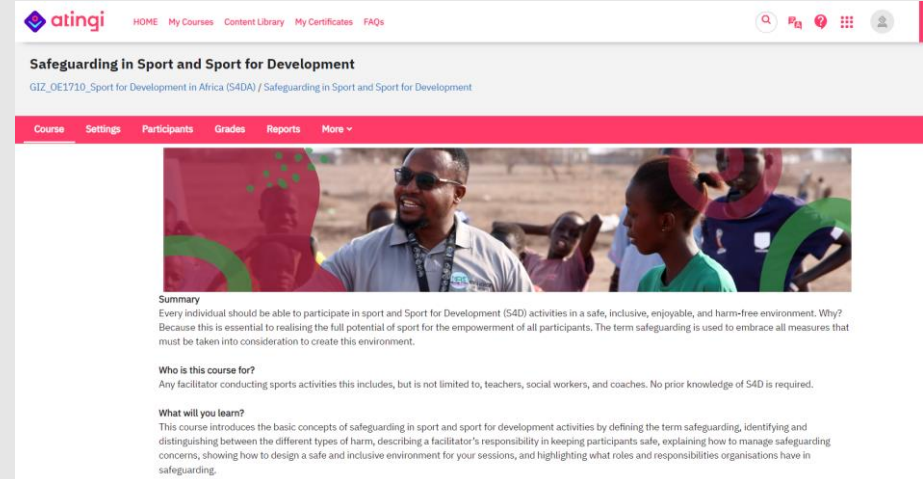
