

TAFISA CLC LEVEL 2

BACKGROUND

Through TAFISA's evaluation of the CLC programme and skill and needs analysis, as well as increasing demand from CLC hosts to further train CLC participants, TAFISA's CLC Level 2 was developed to help trainees to brush up on CLC training, increase their knowledge in Sport for All, enhance implementation of TAFISA Mission 2030, and contribute to the realisation of Sustainable Development Goals.

The CLC Level 2 is aligned with the goals of 'TAFISA Mission 2030: For a Better World through Sport for All' within the framework of Mission 2030's 13 key themes. The objectives are as follows:

- To complement existing CLC Educational programme
- To serve as a tool for the Sport for All community to learn, develop ideas and exchange knowledge and experiences as well as empower stakeholders from all s and areas of the Sport for All Movement
- To address specific societal questions, issues, and themes where Sport for All can contribute to make a change
- To educate sport leaders to achieve a more active society
- To further train CLC Level 1 Graduates in specific focus areas related to TAFISA Mission 2030 and the UN SDGs
- To support local, national, and international sport organisations in the implementation of Sport For All and Physical Activity programmes and events
- To promote HEPA and Sport for All, and further contribute to effective implementation of SDGs

STRUCTURE

The contents of CLC can be tailored to suit local demand, and typically includes:

- Opening and Closing Ceremony including presentations of certificates
- 4 working days including lectures and interactive, group work sessions
- Introductory session to TAFISA's Mission 2030 and UN SDGs
- 4 modules to be selected by the host according to its needs and priorities, among the 13 available modules which are corresponding to the TAFISA Mission 2030 themes
